# The Norwegian Crime Prevention Council (1)

- **Established in 1980**
- **Board of 10 – appointed by the King**
- **Permanent staff of 7**
- **The governmental body of expertise in the crime prevention field**

# The Norwegian Crime Prevention Council - KRÅD (2)

- **Administered by The Ministry of Justice**
- **Independent in any political and professional matters**

# The Norwegian Crime Prevention Council (3)

- **Main challenges:**
  - Youth crime
  - Immigrant youth crime
  - Information
  - Public discussion
  - Safer communities
  - Coordination of the cooperation in municipalities

# SLT =

- **Coordination of local crime prevention efforts**
- **SLT is supported by The Norwegian Crime Prevention Council**

# What is SLT?

- **SLT is a model for cooperation, not a program of activities**
- **The goal is to get more efficient use of already ongoing measures**
- **By getting different services to support and complete each other**

# WHAT DO WE NEED?

- **Knowledge about**
  - **living conditions for children and young people**
  - **criminality and delinquent behaviour**
  - **adequate prevention activities**

# WHAT ELSE DO WE NEED?

- **Consciousness**
  - about the importance of common goals
- **Time**
  - to meet and cooperate
- **Willingness**
  - to succeed by common effort

# SLT` s three main principles:

- **SLT has to be integrated in the top level of the police as well as in the municipal authorities**
- **SLT has to have a board of top leaders**
- **SLT has to have a coordinator**
