## **JUNIOR ANALYST**

The ICPC is looking for a Junior Analyst, with the appropriate background and skills, interested in working in an international organisation and with policy makers, practitioners and researchers in the field of crime prevention.

ICPC is an international forum for national governments, local authorities, public agencies, specialised institutions, and non-government organisations to exchange experience, consider emerging knowledge, and improve policies and programmes in crime prevention and community safety. The ICPC brings together some twenty non-governmental organisations and a dozen governments from around the world. ICPC staff monitors and analyses trends, provides direct assistance to members, and contributes to public knowledge and understanding in the field. ICPC works in collaboration with the UNODC (United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime) and UN-Habitat including the Safer Cities Programme.

### **Main Duties**

- The Junior Analyst will primarily assist Senior staff members to **conceptualize and provide technical assistance in the implementation of crime observtaories:**
  - To monitor and provide updates on crime observatories which have been developed in different regions of the world
  - To collaborate in the development of a guide on crime observatories
  - To participate in technical assistance missions on crime observatories
- In addition, the junior analyst will **also contribute to the collective activities of the Centre**, most notably,
  - **Contribute to the preparation** of the International Report on Crime Prevention and Community Safety: Trends and Perspectives
  - **Participate in conducting various comparative analyses** on diverse subjects in crime prevention
