## **SENIOR ANALYST**

The ICPC is looking for Research Analysts, with the appropriate background and skills, interested in working **in an international organisation** and with policy makers, practitioners and researchers in the field of crime prevention.

ICPC is an international forum for national governments, local authorities, public agencies, specialised institutions, and non-government organisations to exchange experience, consider emerging knowledge, and improve policies and programmes in crime prevention and community safety. The ICPC brings together some twenty non-governmental organisations and a dozen governments from around the world. ICPC staff monitors and analyses trends, provides direct assistance to members, and contributes to public knowledge and understanding in the field. ICPC works in collaboration with the *UNODC (United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime)* and *UN-Habitat including the Safer Cities Programme*.

## **ACTIVITIES**

- The Senior Analyst will mainly be responsible for preparing the *International Report on Crime Prevention and Community safety: Trends and Perspectives*:
  - **Identify and examine scientific literature** (monographs, reviews and research reports), in addition to grey papers, reports, working documents and strategic plans produced by inter-governmental or non-governmental organisations, and international, national and local organisations on issues related to crime prevention,
  - **Undertake analysis, and prepare succinct summaries, and reports** on developments and trends, for colleagues and crime prevention stakeholders.
  - **Establish and maintain strategic policy and research links** with local correspondents on selected issues in ICPC's network of countries that will help to support the production of

- **Providing regular information up-dates** on selected practices, tools and strategies for ICPC's knowledge-base, its members and partners.
- **Examine and document current news event items** concerning crime prevention across the world, and identify pertinent crime prevention policies and inspiring practices for the international report.

The Senior Analyst is also expected to contribute to ICPC's General Activities.

- **Help to enhance communication tools** to disseminate knowledge
