Il a aussi agi en qualité de secrétaire du CIPC pendant 13 ans.

Michel Marcus is the General Delegate of the European Forum for Urban Safety and of the French Forum for Urban Safety. He was an Advisor to the French Commission of Mayors on Safety in the early 1980's, Deputy General Delegate of the National Crime Prevention Council from 1984 to 1987 and General Secretary of the National Council of Cities between 1989 and 1994. He served as ICPC's Secretary for 13 years.

- In 2007, participation in the Committee in charge of drafting **Bogotá's Integral Safety and Prevention 2007-2017 Plan**

- The Forum organises International interdisciplinary events (Paris 1991, Naples 2000).
- The last conference took place in Saragossa on November 2-4 2006 on the theme « Security, Democracy and Cities » and gathered more than **800 participants from 220 cities in 40 countries.**
